Laws in more and more states, starting with California, require organizations to publicly announce when data is missing and personal information like social security numbers and financial information is jeopardized. With each passing day, more legal mandates are established to protect sensitive digital data. The legal liability for your organization's lost data is real—and your responsibility to protect against that liability is also real.
